Due to the current Covid pandemic times are very difficult at the moment – we do intend to get another female GP in the future.

### **Do patients need to do anything ?**

No – everything will be done for you – your records will change from Dr. Dhillon's name to Dr. Johal's name through NHS England. Dr. Johal will be your named GP.

Ordering prescriptions will be done exactly the same as previously via the POD or Access online.

The practice team will be the same - Receptionists, Practice Nurse, Practice Secretary and Practice Manager.
